 - "Why should the scholarship committee choose you over other applicants?"
 - "How will the IBEW 733 Scholarship aid in achieving your educational and career goals?"

***Additional* Requirements for the \$2,000 Scholarship**

- Two letters of recommendation
- Resume (optional) – outlining education, work history, special honors or awards, extracurricular activities, and involvement in civic, community, or religious affairs)

Rules and Acknowledgement

- The IBEW Local 733 Scholarship is only open to eligible students attending a college or trade school during the 2024 to 2025 school year. Eligible students are defined as a child, step-child, or grandchild of an IBEW 733 member in good standing.

- A confirmation email will be sent upon verified receipt of each application.
- Recipients will be selected based on academic achievement and essay merit (at the sole discretion of the IBEW Local 733 scholarship committee) and will be notified and announced at the following local union meeting on July 2nd.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution upon presentment of a bill / invoice from the school. Any unused funds can be carried over up to one year.
- All applicants agree not to hold the IBEW Local 733, its scholarship committee, its members, or its affiliates responsible for any claims, demands, or actions arising from the scholarship selection process or outcomes.
